Residents will be charged \$10 per car/truck load AND \$10 for trailers per load to dispose of these materials.

CURB SIDE PICK-UP OF YARD RAKINGS, BRUSH, GARDEN WASTE, AND SMALL BRANCHES (NO LONGER THAN 4') WILL BEGIN THE WEEK OF MAY 20TH.

BE SURE TO HAVE ALL YARD DEBRIS AT CURBSIDE BY 7 AM ON MAY 20th AS ONCE WE PICK UP ON YOUR STREET WE WILL NOT RETURN.

NOTICE: Please do not place artificial flowers on gravesites until after May 15th at Evergreen Memorial Cemetery. Articles on the gravesites prior to May 15th will be disposed of during the spring clean up process.

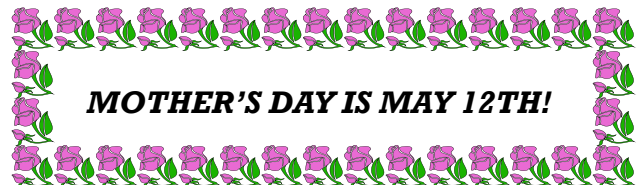
